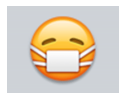


CORONAVIRUS UPDATE – IMPORTANT

The key points communicated in last week's leaflet regarding service protocols at St Mary's are:

- All pews now back in use, parishioners free to choose their own seating position in church but are asked to be mindful and respectful of others
- No longer a need to pre-register attendance, however in support of the aims of Track and Trace we will continue to keep a register of attendees' names on arrival at church which will be destroyed after 3 weeks
- Parishioners are encouraged to continue to wear face masks in church
- Communion will continue to be given in one kind until further notice, and the sign of the Peace will be shared without physical contact

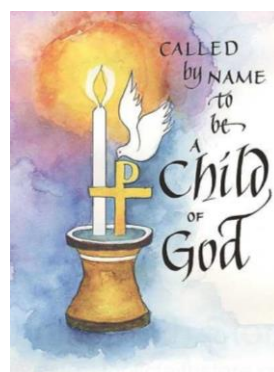
Archdeacon's Open Meeting – 15th Sept
